The table below outlines how your presentations will be graded. The grade will be based on three criteria. The criteria are content, presentation, and neatness/structure/grammar each worth 20, 10, and 10 respectively for a total of 40 points. Your grade will be determined by how well you follow the guidelines below.

	Poor example. Several Omissions or mistakes. Poster read with long pauses or overruns. Map is useless. Evident lack of preparation. 60%	Below expectations. 1 or 2 mistakes or omissions.
